#### Conference Keynote Thursday, March 7th

I Don't Wanna Talk About it: Creative Interventions to Engage Children and Youth in Counseling Led by Liana Lowenstein, MSW, RSW, CPT-S



Working with difficult to engage youth can be frustrating and challenging, even for seasoned counselors. The challenge of working with younger clients in therapy can be further compounded by their fear of entering therapy, their lack of control over the decision to attend therapy, and their developmental capacity which can make it difficult for them to respond to traditional talk-therapy. This workshop will outline innovative strategies for engaging hard-to-reach children and teens. Videos

of client sessions and fun, experiential activities will be included.

Liana Lowenstein, MSW, RSW, CPT-S, is a Registered Clinical Social Worker, Certified Play Therapist-Supervisor, and Certified TF-CBT Therapist who has been working with children and their families since 1988. She provides clinical supervision to mental health practitioners, runs a play-therapy internship program, and consults to several mental health agencies. Liana's 12 books on child and family therapy are known internationally for their innovative and practical techniques. She is winner of the Monica Herbert award for outstanding contribution to play therapy in Canada.

#### **Conference Keynote Friday, March 8th**

Trauma Treatment for Diverse Populations Led by Dr. Ryan Day, LPC, CPCS, CETP



Dr. Ryan Day is an Assistant Professor of Counselor Education at Columbus State University (CSU), a proud Licensed Professional Counselor (LPC), Certified Professional Counselor Supervisor (CPCS), Certified School Counselor, and a Certified Expert Trauma Professional (CETP). He serves as the School Counseling Program Coordinator at CSU. He is the founder of The Healing Center for Change, which is a mental health outpatient center that specializes in trauma and family treatment located in Atlanta, GA. Dr. Day has 12 years of counseling and psychotherapy treatment experience working with a wide variety of diverse populations consisting of

military, various SES, and ethnicities. In 2014 he was nominated as an Emerging Leader Fellow from the Southern Association of Counselor Education and Supervision (SACES). Dr. Day was featured on the VH1 reality tv show, "K. Michelle: My Life," conducting a live counseling session and participated as a guest expert professional on a live radio show, Jazz WCLK Atlanta, speaking on PTSD and Childhood Trauma. He was featured in the Atlanta Journal-Constitution Newspaper interviewed on the topic of "Racial Trauma." In 2016, Dr. Day received the 2016 Counselor Educator of the Year award by the Licensed Professional Counselor Association of Georgia (LPCA of GA). In 2017, he was selected as the 2017 Columbus State University College of Education & Health Profession Distinguish Teacher of the Year. Dr. Day presents at state, regional, and national conferences on trauma research and clinical expertise.
